

ASSUMPTION OF RISK and INFORMED CONSENT

By acknowledging review of this document, you understand and accept the risks associated with a membership for your child as his or her parent or legal guardian.

Please read carefully!

In consideration of permission, granted now or in the future by the River Valley Junior Golf Club (RVJGC-E) to participate in events and activities associated with membership with the RVJGC-E, *which may include activities such as driving range, putting green, chipping area, or indoor and outdoor lessons. Lessons/events will be conducted in a variety of weather conditions.*

I agree and acknowledge that:

1. My Child has met all of the prerequisites required for participation in a membership at RVJGC-E.
2. My Child will abide by the rules and regulations imposed on the participants for any and all events organized and available with RVJGC-E.
3. There are risks and hazards inherent in the very nature of golf and that as a result of these risks and hazards, my Child, may suffer personal injury, even death, as well as property loss. I nevertheless freely and voluntarily assume the aforementioned risks and hazards and accordingly my Child's participation in any events and activities with RVJGC-E shall be entirely at my own risk.
4. I waive any claim I may have against the River Valley Junior Golf Club - Edmonton arising from my Child's participation in all events and activities through RVJGC-E and agree to indemnify and hold harmless the River Valley Junior Golf Club for any claim, including any claim for medical services arising from my Child's participation in any events or activities associated with RVJGC-E.
5. The RVJGC-E may secure such medical advice and services as it, in its sole discretion, may deem necessary for my health and safety and I shall be financially responsible for such advice and services.
6. I agree to provide the required adult supervision for my child as deemed appropriate by RVJGC-E and the City of Edmonton and adhere to the policy for active adult supervision for my child should he/she be under the age of 10.
